Dear Parents,

At the beginning of this academic year we renewed our Behaviour Policy and Anti-Bullying Policy and I am writing now to ensure that parents from across school know where to find them. Both policies are available on our school website in the "Key Info" section. Promoting and maintaining high standards and expectations of children's behaviour is something that we take very seriously at Grange Farm Primary School.

The Behaviour Policy details the school wide praise and reward systems that we have in place at Grange Farm. Our children make many great choices in their learning and behaviour every day and it is lovely to be able to celebrate these so often with the whole school community through the newsletter and in achievement assemblies every Friday. I conduct regular formal and informal visits to classrooms across school (and the playground) with a range of visitors. Comments and observations about the calm learning atmosphere and environment are consistently positive – a credit to children and staff across the school.

The policy also covers what happens when children's choices are not as positive. Any behavioural incidents and concerns at Grange Farm are dealt with in line with our Behaviour Policy. We investigate issues thoroughly, put consequences in place and contact parents where needed. We also carefully monitor patterns in behaviour over time and will put support, intervention and strategies into place to support individuals and groups where necessary, including additional levels of adult support and supervision and external professional advice and support.

Supporting children's learning, whether academic, personal or social, always works best when school and home are working in partnership and this is a two-way relationship. We recognise that every parent wants the best for their child and we want to know if and when you have any concerns – we will always aim to be approachable and to listen. You can contact your child's class teacher by speaking to them directly or through the school office by email or by phone. We want the best for your child and every child that comes to Grange Farm. We are committed to ensuring that all children thrive at school and we really value constructive and supportive relationships with parents that help us to achieve these common goals together.
