### **SPORTS DAY – THURSDAY 28 JUNE 2018**

This year our KS2 children (Year 3 to 6) will have their Sports Day events at the University of Warwick Westwood track in the morning and our Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 will have their events in the afternoon at school. Everyone will join together for a family picnic at the school at lunchtime.

The morning event at the University of Warwick will run from 9.30 a.m. to 12.15 p.m. The children are being transported to and from the Athletics Track by coach. As usual parents and friends of pupils are welcome to attend. Ample parking is available at the Athletics Track although parents should be aware that parking rules and charges apply.

As this site is open to public access the children will need to remain in their allocated groups at all times and not wander off to be with relatives and friends. The children's safety is paramount and we need to know where they are at any given time. After the event, parents are invited to return to the school site to join the children for lunch from approximately 12.30 p.m. until 1.15 p.m.

The afternoon event for Reception and KS1 will start at 1.30 p.m. and finish at the end of the school day. All parents are invited to join the children for lunch from 12.30 p.m.

Friends of Grange Farm will be selling cakes and biscuits at the school at lunchtime and would be very grateful for donations. Please could you bring them into school on Friday morning. Please ensure that you clearly mark any containers that you want to be returned with your child's name and year group.

All children are expected to attend school for the whole day and remain in school until the finish time of 3.30 p.m.

Please ensure that the children have their PE kit with them on the day (white t shirt, black shorts) or come to school suitably dressed. As the children will be spending a large amount of time outside please can we remind parents to ensure that they have sufficient sun cream applied before school, bring a cap to wear and have a water bottle with them.

Sports day takes a large amount of organisation and we know it is difficult for many parents to organise work to be able to attend so we will proceed with the event as planned unless the weather is particularly inclement. In the event of us having to rearrange any part of the day, we will advise parents as soon as possible.
