Young Voices Performance – Thursday 17 January 2019 – 7.00 p.m.

On the day of the concert, the children will attend school as usual and be taken by coach to the Genting Arena, Birmingham at approximately 12.15 p.m. (They will have an early lunch – school dinner or packed lunch from home – we would recommend that they have a hot school meal). After the concert, all children will return by coach to the school where parents can pick up their children. They will arrive back to school at approximately 10.00 p.m.

Please ensure your child brings a large packed lunch and drinks for their evening meal as it is a long day for them. Please send this in a disposable bag. Please can the children come to school in either their Young Voices T shirt or a plain white, round necked T shirt which they will wear with their usual school trousers/skirt.

For parents and children wanting to know more about Young Voices they can access the website (youngvoices.co.uk) where they will find lots of information to help them prepare for the big day. On the website is a link to 'Music Room' where the children will be able to access all the songs and lyrics to enable them to rehearse at home as well as our two sessions in school. If a password is required please type in the following 'Popmedley2019'.

There is also a Young Voices app which we recommend parents download. This will give you the exact seating of our choir in the arena on the day, giving you the opportunity to look out for your children. We will also be taking a banner to hang in front of the choir.

Young Voices support the charity Fareshare and they ask that each child donate a tin of food, which they can bring with them on the day which will then be distributed to the homeless. This is not compulsory.

We hope that the children are enjoying being part of such a huge event and we are sure that this will be an experience that they never forget.
